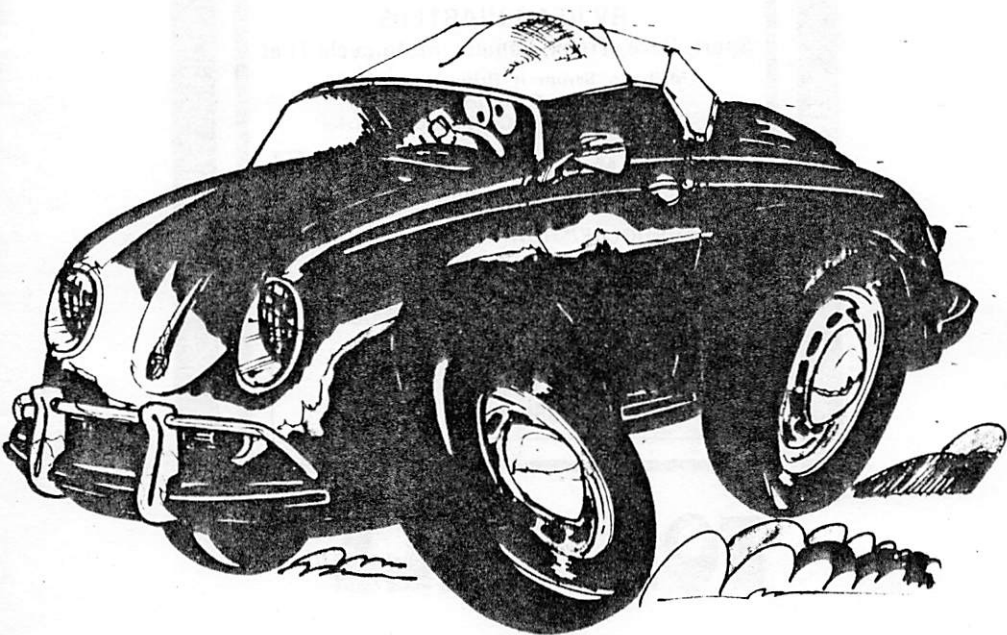

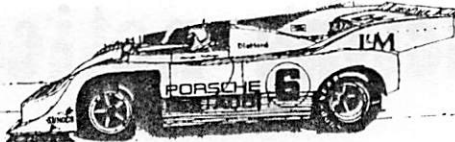

On July 27 Schattenbaum Region will hold the third event in the Tri-Regional Autocross Series. Like the other events in the series there will be trophies presented at the event. The site will be the Gloucester County College which is convenient to all members of Presentoter. Directions to the event are:

Cross the Walt Whitman bridge into New Jersey. Follow the signs to Route I-295. Take I-295 South to the Rt -47 South exit. Go south on Rt-47 to the fourth traffic light from I-295 and turn right. Go one block to the stop sign and turn left. Gloucester County College is 1.2 miles on the left. Registration will begin at 9:30 AM and the first car off will be at 10:30 AM. Entrance fee will be \$8.00. Tri-region rules and classes will be in effect with non-Porsche classes added so those with out-of-service Porsches can run the family bus. Reservations must be received before July 23rd to attend. Adherence to this deadline is a must as the wine quantities must be ordered by this date.

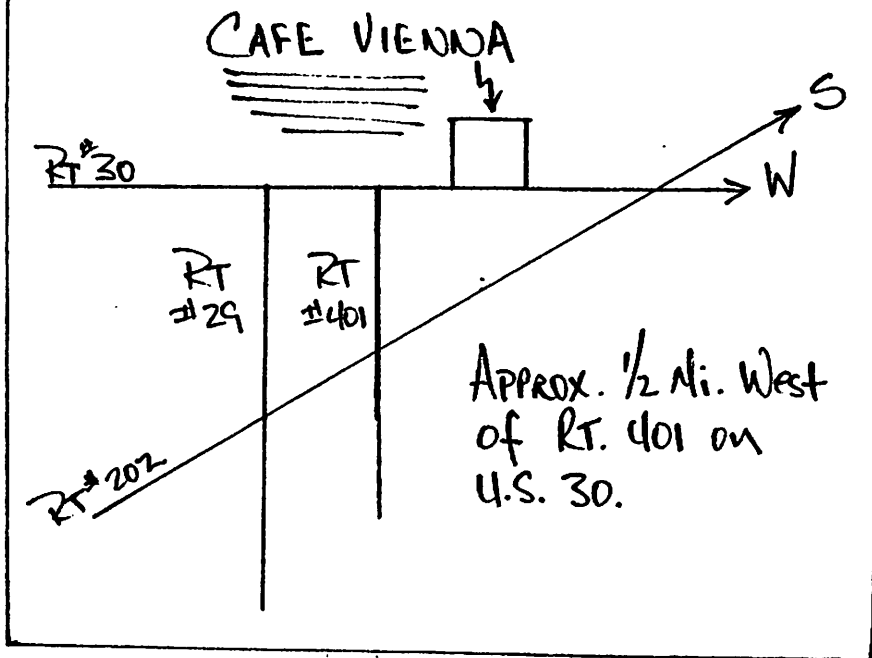
The cost for dinner and the wine tasting is \$15.00 per person.

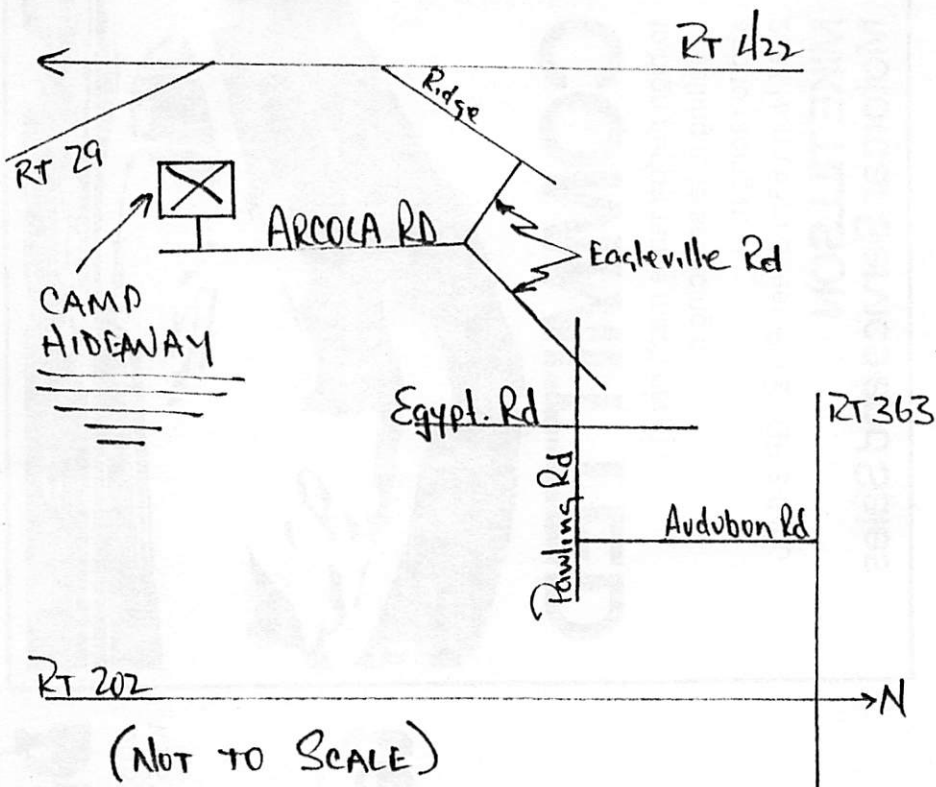

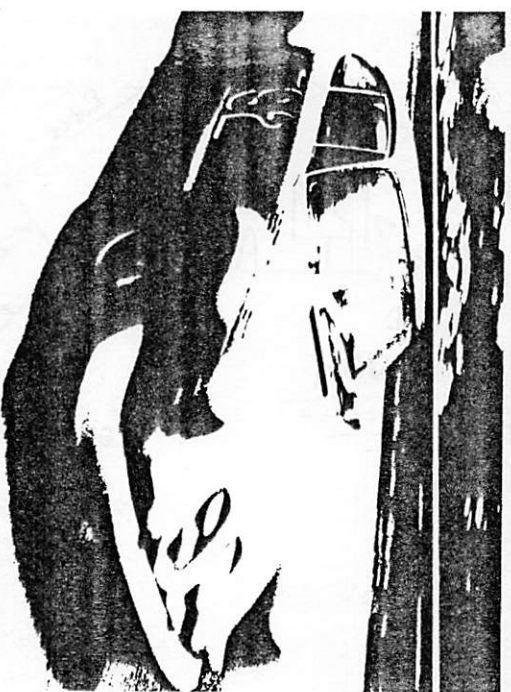
