The bad news of the day is that Tom Anderson, as spokesman for the local independent service station operators, has just announced that his association members are going to close their stations for 7 or 8 days. The good news is, that we will have all that gas available when they reopen. If you believe that, then you need a refresher course in economics. To wit, the price of gasoline is "controlled" by the U.S. Government, and a phase-in period has been announced whereby these controls will be gradually lifted, until in 1981 the price will be set by the market. Now common sense tells us that gradual decontrol persuades everybody that prices will be higher tomorrow, so everyone concerned, from oil company to service station to the individual motorist, acts to make whatever shortage there might actually be, worse, by topping off his supply.
