

Our track season opened at Pocono, much the same as it has for as long as I can remember. Last year, at our October Pocono event, Virginia

the past tried to have our events on the weekend and add the Friday if it is to be a three-day event. This year, we could not get Friday and decided to try Monday instead. We combined the two days at the Jefferson Circuit with a day at Summit Point. Last year we were approached to see if



we would consider having a run group for women only. JC seemed like it would be a good place to

try this. Well, it worked and we did it again this year. This year we had fourteen participants in the "yellow" group and it looks like we will continue this in the future. Do we have enough interest for a "yellow" group at Pocono? Ladies, let me



know. For those of you that have never been to JC, it is a 1.1 mile c o u r s e designed to be run in either direction. The

course has seven turns. Three of them (turns one, two and three) make up the "esses". Turn four is an increasing radius turn and turn seven is a decreasing radius turn. It is very interesting to watch the different lines through these turns. There is a little elevation change to make things interesting. It's not the same kind of change as Summit Point, but enough to add interest. We run the course up the "esses" on Saturday and



down the "esses" on Sunday. One of the benefits of JC is the availability of a skid pad. I want to thank Bob Russo for helping out and running the skid pad. Our normal skip pad instructor was out in Colorado squeezing his Excursion between rocks. After the last run on Sunday we loaded up for the trip to Summit - all three minutes of it. Summit Point in a while, they haverepaved the entire course and it is a big improve-



ment. As I stated earlier, the temperature over the three days was very hot and very humid. I want to thank all of the instructors that jumped




