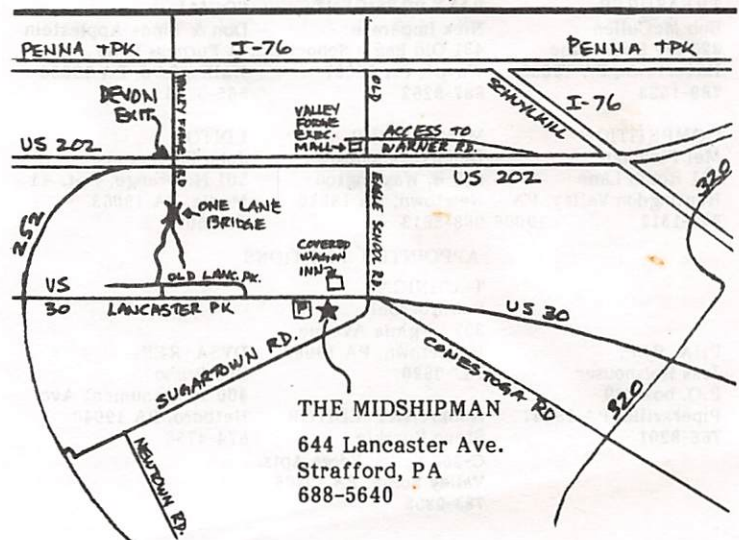
MEETING PROGRAM

SPRING SPRINT SCHOOL

Spring Season means Sprint Season. This year we are trying something new with the novice driver in mind. On May 15th we are holding a Sprint School designed for the members of our club that have never sprinted, so that they may experience the thrill of driving quickly without having to worry about traffic or Smokey. We know there are a lot of you out there who would love to get out on a track and see what you can do without thinking about competition. Here you will have an experienced sprinter to instruct you on the finer points of driving. Whether 911, 914, 356 or 924, we'll have someone to show you how to get the most out of your car. Your laps will be timed so you can see the improvement you make over the day.

I'm sure one of the reasons many of you have never sprinted is the maze of pylons you have seen or heard about criss-crossing large parking lots. I'll admit that, in the beginning, one worries more about where the next turn is than how that turn should be negotiated.

This Sprint School, however, will be held at Christmas Village (see map), a go-cart track in Bernville, Pa. (near Reading): no pylons, just a road course, so all you have to do is follow the blacktop and you have it made.

In one day you can learn more about the handling of your car than in years of driving on the highways. Knowing what your car will do at

its limit can mean not being surprised in an emergency situation on the road. This knowledge could help you control your car while making an evasive move to avoid an accident. For this reason alone, most of you should be on hand May 15th.

On June 5th, July 10th, and then again on August 7th we will have competitive sprints at Christmas Village. For these we are going to have trophies for novice sprinters in all classes. As of now there will probably be six classes. We are going to run low-pressure meets so you can get the most fun out of them.

Now that Vern Lyle (last month) and I have told you what it's all about, let's see a lot of new faces May 15th. Better yet, come to the April meeting and talk to some of the experienced sprinters like Vern L., Bob A., Ted S., Bob P., Joe L., Bob R., and myself.

You can find out who I mean by coming to a meeting: we would all be happy to sit down and talk to you about driving your toy. Come to the April 27th meeting and hear more about the school and the sprints. We would be encouraged to see some new faces at the meeting along with new ideas and suggestions.

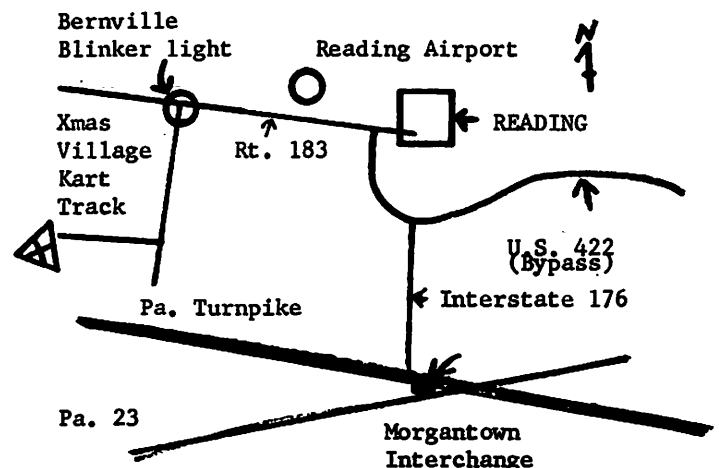

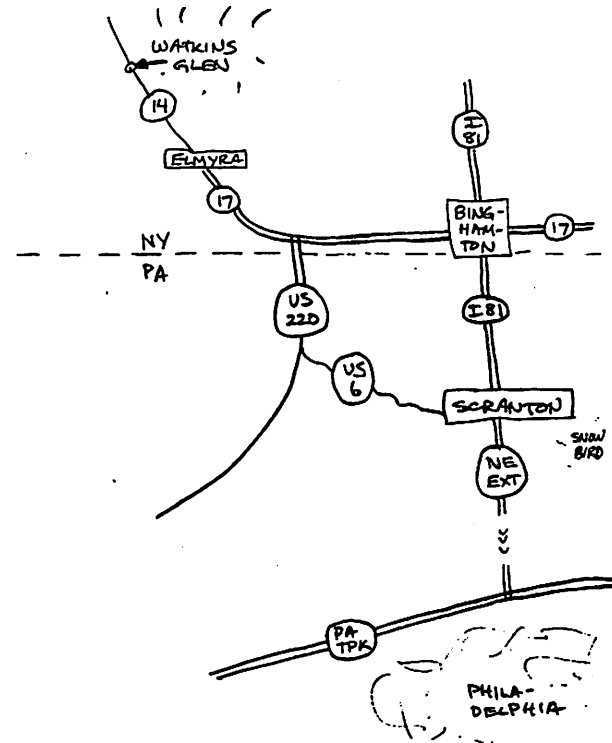


BEST ROUTE TO TRACK: Pa. Tpk. to Morgantown exit; follow signs to Interstate 176; stay on 176 until intersection with U.S. 422 bypass west; stay on 422 around Reading, then keep a sharp eye out for Pa. Route 183 signs. Stay on 183, past the Reading Airport about 8-10 miles to the blinker light at Bernville; left at blinker, then follow signs to "Christmas Village."
