- 5. Cars with racing tires will have 2% added to their times


Those of you who missed our first sprint still have a shot at the series awards. If you are so inclined, I'll see you on July 10th at Xmas Village.

Stay on 183, past the Reading Airport about 8-10 miles to the blinker light at Bernville; left at blinker, then follow signs to "Christmas Village."


