
PRIZES will be awarded to winners of the baking contest and the concours.


Thus far, my term as president of Riesentoter region has had it's disappointments as well as it's joys.

Despite the ups and downs it has been enjoyable and interesting. I have made many new friends and acquaintances.


The experience has made PCA much more enjoyable to me than just being a member.

ROUTE TO CHRISTMAS VILLAGE HOME OF THE RIESENTOTER SPRINTS



Exit from Pa. Turnpike at the Morgantown exit; follow signs to I 176; take I 176 to US 422 bypass west; take that around Reading and watch for Route 183 signs (and Airport signs). Take Pa. 183 west, past Airport by about 8 miles. Watch for marked detour. Take detour (left onto a new road). Note teeny signs directing you to Christmas Village. TECH SESSION AUGUST 20


Holbert's will host our next tech session. Two items of interest will be covered:




HILLCLIMBING

Dennis Frick: 57.541 Eric Wagner: 57.550 Dave Derecola: 57.595


How about that for competition!

Keep it between the trees.




MAP TO PAGODA HILLCLIMB


(Hillclimb is run up Duryea Drive which starts in Reading Park in the center of Reading, PA. It finishes at Pagoda.)


