Riesentöter has two events scheduled in the DVSA calendar, both championship events: May 21 and August 6. Through the efforts of our Competition Chairman Paul Walsack we have secured the use of the Bucks County Community College as our site this year. There are twelve Drivers Championships scheduled for 1978. This number may fluctuate with the availability of some sites, but in general it is necessary to run in only half the events to qualify for a year-end trophy: this was done in the hope of making it easier for more people to qualify.

All sessions were well attended.

The Annual Awards Banquet was held in the evening to award trophies to the competitors for the 1977 season.

At my suggestion, Dick Sweigart has agreed to take the appointed position of our club's PHA Representative for 1978. Dick has held the post a number of times in the past, as have I, so we may look forward to his resuming his good efforts.
