

Cross the Walt Whitman bridge into New Jersey. Follow the signs to Route I-295. Take I-295 South to the Bt -47 South exit. Go south on Rt-47 to the fourth traffic light from I-295 and turn right. Go one block to the stop sign and turn left. Gloucester County College is 1.2 miles on the left. Registration will begin at 9:30 AM and the first car off will be at 10:30 AM. Entrance fee will be \$8.00. Tri-region rules and classes will be in effect with non-Porsche classes added so those with out-of-service Porsches can run the family bus. 
Reservations must be received before July 23rd to attend. Adherence to this deadline is a must as the wine quantities must be ordered by this date.
