

# PORSCHE



Pocono Raceway was the location of Riesentoter's first driver education event of 1987 on Friday slightly 10th. Despite chilly temperatures early in the morning, sunny skies soon warmed things up for the ninety drivers in attendance. Der Gasser's Editor (thats me) even got permission to take off work for a day to attend his first ever driving event.

While air shifting Al Holberts 962 from the comfort of your living room chair may be as close as most people would care to get appreciating the capabilities of their Porsche, there were 21 first timers finding out what the other seventy already knew - this is fun. It is also and more importantly educational. If you think the quickest way around a corner is to turn the wheel and follow the white line, you would probably learn something at one of these events. And although you're not supposed to drive at maximum speed in daily driving, (learned something already didn't you) if you've ever been on an unfamiliar road late at night and suddenly found a curve and a tree where they weren't supposed to be, having good control of your car in a corner can be real helpful.

As Bob Lamb, our competition

chairman pointed out, the other primary concern of all driving events is safety. This is not a race and you don't have to go any faster than you feel capable of. All drivers are assigned instructor who rides with until they have the experience to handle the car on their Riesentoters instructors, under the able direction of Don Galbraith, all have a great deal of experience and deserve a lot of credit for their patience and effort. instructor for the day was Richard Van zijl who did a terrific job of helping me get the most out of my first event.

My only minor mishap of the day was caused by a rare occurrence in which a sudden shift in the earths crust causes a curve to suddenly become tighter, causing ones car to quickly change direction. Since everyone else chose to complete the lap going forward and not backward I decided to stop, change direction and go forward again. 
# SOCIAL CALENDAR



# DRIVERS ED 87


This was written a week before our Pocono event. 90 people are signed up from five different States. We have a large number of first-timers. We are hoping for good weather and a fun day.






