


# President's Message

I haven't felt this good in a long time. Track Chairman Mike Andrews, Chief Instructor Kurt Faller and a whole host of Riesentöters pulled together one of the better-run events that I have attended. Forethought, planning and cool thinking under pressure really paid off for these two guys while the wind blew but the sun shined over Pocono International Raceway. I had a personal best with finally being able to enter Turn 1 the way Bertil Roos says you're supposed to. Flat out in 5th gear at the end of the main straight, Bertil says give it a little lift, dive for the apex and squeeze the throttle back on being flat out at the apex. Just when you think you are going to die, jump on the brakes, drop two gears and dive for the next apex. Yah Hoo!

A group of us went to Nazareth on Friday to try to watch the Indy cars practice. The moment we stepped from our vehicles in the parking lot, it began to rain. It showered on and off most of the day so we never got to see a race car turn a wheel. Actually, they go so fast you can hardly see them anyway. Nick Plenzick and I wanted to hear them. They're twisting those V-6's to somewhere around 12,000 RPM. That's music to this motorhead's ears. While it rained, I played race fan and sought autographs. Michael Andretti, Steffen Johansson, Scott Pruitt, Hiro Matshusita, Dean Hall and David Hobbs were gracious enough to ink the pages of my Autoweek Official Indy Car Fan Guide. Nazareth is a pretty little track owned by Roger Penske. I think it would be FUN to start a tradition of going to the Indy Car practice on Friday and then on up to Pocono for our annual Track Event on Friday night, which is exactly what we did!

The Ramada Inn served as our Headquarters, and the Techmeisters Plenzick along with Shannon and "Hooked-Up Jimmy" Foster and a group of fellow torque wrench-wielding crazies teched somewhere around 25 cars over the course of an hour and a half, right under the portico of the hotel. #### JULY




#### AUGUST



Well the April novice school is history as you read this article. The site delivered everything promised. With the early arrival of Bill Vaughn and Pres. John Heckman, the course and most of the other ancillary items were ready to go except for the absent participants who were delayed or rejected at the Ben Franklin Bridge.

After the challenge of getting to the site, which was significantly complicated by the closure of the Ben Franklin Bridge between 8:30 am and 9:15 am approx. 30 participants showed up for the soon to be very rainy novice school. Of the 30 participants, 10 were non PCA members.

I would like to thank the volunteers who showed up...In no particular order Bill Vaughn (founder of the memorial Bill Vaughn Autocross site), John Heckman, Tony Bonanni, Dennis Angelisanti, Bob Weigand and from the SCCA - Andre Downey, John and Jack Banha.

The course consisted of three phases which were combined after 4 practice runs into a complete course. They consisted of open gates, skid pad and slalom (decreasing) with instructors strategically placed to offer coaching and encouragement. The course averaged better than 1 min.

The novices showing noticeable improvement throughout the day included Jeff Sheldon and Peter Stillwell with an 11 sec improvement throughout the day (even as the day got wetter and wetter), Dave Schanerhorn driving a 928 with a 6 sec improvement. It was also rumored that Jim Foster beat Shannon who was heard saying "I wish he would get his own car!!" Sounds like a major rivalry is brewing.


Although the timing equipment presented problems, my nine year old son seemed to have it running by the end of the day!!!
